Automated Workflow

Pulse RTLS can be configured to cancel alarms when a caregiver enters the room where a patient has placed a call. Chimes are automatically muted, resulting in a quieter unit.



Caregiver Visibility

When a staff member enters a patient room, over-door lights are automatically illuminated to let other staff members know where caregivers are located. Similarly, a staff presence alert is displayed on the nurse call interface.



Mobile Assistance

With a simple button press, staff members can send urgent requests for assistance from their exact location. The notifications go directly to the nurse call system and wireless notification devices.



Robust Reporting

Pulse RTLS gathers multiple key performance indicators related to staff and patient interactions, including response time, and time spent in patient rooms. This data is available to staff and clinical leadership through customizable reports.
